## GAS LINES, PETCOCKS & FILTERS

No.	Part No.	Description	Year
1	35B893X	Petcock: Offset with screen	34-42
2	44454	Petcock: Inline	44-53
2	44454R	Petcock: EZ Turn anti sticking	44-53
<b>Note:</b> The EZ Turn petcock has an anti galling coating that requires no lubrication and will not seize with unleaded fuels. Out performs every body elses petcocks hands down.			
<b>Note:</b> Some folks sell a 44454 petcock with a screen on it. This is a total waist of time. Fuel filters should be at the lowest point in the fuel system in order to trap sediment.			
3	41293	Gas line: Use with 35B893X petcock and 42496 filter	34-42
3	44734	Gas line: Use with 44454, 44454R petcock & 42496 filter	44-53
4	892011	Gas line: Use with 44454, 44454R petcock & no filter	44-53
<b>Note:</b> 1938-44 models can be upgraded to using 44454R petcocks. Then use 44734 or 892011 gas lines. These are far better petcocks and a lot cheaper as well			
5	42496	Filter: Gas. Incl #10, 11, 12. Order elbows separately	34-53
6	KI-10203M	Filter kit: Compact & cleanable. Made from billet aluminum. Comes with clamps and hose.	34-53
7	437001R	Elbow w/barb: 1/8" female pipe to 1/4" flexible hose	34-53
8	437001	Elbow: Carb to filter	34-53
9	418001	Elbow: Filter to gas line	34-53
10	42496F	Filter element: Modern replacement "pleated" filter for original style 42496 filters	34-53
11	102730	Viton O-ring: Bowl	34-53
12	102731	Bowl: Filter	34-53

**TECH:** Over the years fuel line related parts get mismatched. It is necessary to match the fuel line with the petcocks you are using. A good example will be many folks have replaced their 35B893x offset 1940 petcocks with 44454R in-line petcocks. It is then necessary to order 44734 gas line and not the 41283.
